**The Ten Fold Special Integrated Rural Development Programme**

**1. Introduction**

The Government aims to develop the country sustainably with a focus on minimizing regional disparities through a more precise rural development approach and to achieve macro-economic goals through establishing such a robust rural economy. A relative decline is observed in public infrastructure facilities and services as well on the living standards of the people in the hill country zone among the rural areas. The access difficulties due to geographical and environmental factors as well as the prevalence of a disparity in the distribution of resources due to social and various other reasons, which are being experienced over a long period of time, have resulted in this situation.

These hill country areas are rich in highly sensitive ecological zones encompassing the Sinharaja and Knuckles rain forest range reserves, Samanala forest range reserve, Horton Plains and its adjacent areas. Further, a vast range of domestic industries, i.e. agricultural, plantations and spices export crops, gem mining, handicrafts, handloom industry, brass, Laksha and carvings arrayed across this geographical area, annually extends a considerable contribution to the national economy. Moreover, implementation of special integrated rural development programmes on priority basis has been evaded since this is an area which frequently encounters disasters as a result of natural catastrophes such as heavy rainfall, floods, earth slips, etc.



Accordingly, the Government has decided to implement **“Kadukara Dashakaya 2024-2033”**, a Special Integrated Rural Development Programme in Central and Sabaragamu Provincial hilly areas and the surrounded highlands over the period of next ten years, based on the **“Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) which is executed as a new approach to eradicate poverty across the world”**. Priority has been given to uplift the living standards of the people of the area through development of socio- economic infrastructure facilities and livelihoods of the relevant areas by this special programme.

Accordingly, this programme shall be implemented in the **Divisional Secretariat Divisions** under the purview of the Districts given in the Annexure 1, targeting **“Tenfold Development”** sectors given in the No. Two (2) herein under.

**Rs.10 Billion** has been allocated as the total provision to launch the first phase of the proposed **Ten Year, Ten Fold Special Integrated Rural Development Programme**, in accordance with the Budget Speech 2024, and approximately **Rs. 100 Million** of provisions have been allocated for each Divisional Secretariat Division for the year 2024. The balance provision shall be utilized to implement the projects prioritized in view of the special requisites which are in consistent with the Ten Fold Integrated Rural Development Approach, based on the approval of the Presidential Secretariat.

Since this programme is implemented with the aim of achieving Ten Fold Rural Development in conformity with the Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI), it shall be ensured not to implement projects in local authority areas of Municipal Councils and Urban Councils situated in the Divisional Secretariat Divisions of the selected Districts, utilizing the funds of this programme. Accordingly, provision allocated for such Divisional Secretariat Division for the year 2024 shall be notified by the Presidential Secretariat taking into consideration the number of Grama Niladhari Divisions and population of such local authority areas of the Divisional Secretariat Divisions in which such Municipal Councils and Urban Councils are located and action shall be taken by the relevant Divisional Secretary to get the necessary provisions allocated having sent such information to the Presidential Secretariat expeditiously with copies to the District Secretary.

## **2. Ten Fold Development Sectors**

The Government has planned to implement this rural development programme by means of the Ten Fold Development Approach herein under given which is proposed to be launched in conformity with the Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI). Ten (10) sub-areas covered by the proposed development approach are as follows and the detailed description is given in the Annexure 2.

- i. Livelihood, Food Security, Market Development and Promotion of the Tourism Industry
- ii. Education
- iii. Drinking Water Facilities
- iv. Access Road Facilities
- v. Agricultural and Minor Irrigation
- vi. Electricity and Renewable Energy
- vii. Telephone, Internet Facilities
- viii. Health and Sanitary Facilities
- ix. Environmental Conservation and Disaster Management
- x. Upgrading Housing Facilities

### **3. Identification of Requirements and Approval**

#### **3.1 Rural Level**

3.1.1 It is expected to identify all the development requirement which need to be fulfilled at divisional level on priority basis by the **“Rural Committees”** established at the Grama Niladhari Division level with the contribution of all the stakeholders **prior to 16<sup>th</sup> February 2024**. These **“Rural Committees”** shall consist of the following stakeholders based on the needs of each area.

- The Clergy
- Rural level Community Leaders of the Registered Community Based Organizations
- Heads of Educational and Health Institutions
- Business Community of the area
- Office Bearers of Entrepreneur Societies such as Agricultural, Rural Industries
- All Government field officers working in the Grama Niladhari Division
- Government and Private Sector Officers related to the fields such as Water, Electricity, Telephone and Internet Facilities, Environment Conservation and Disaster Management
- Other appropriate stakeholders called by the Divisional Secretary as necessary.

3.1.2 Economic Development Officer of the respective Grama Niladhari Division shall act as the Convener of this Rural Committee and all the development needs identified at the Rural Committee shall be discussed and prioritized with the Rural Committee and submitted to the Divisional Secretariat by the Economic Development Officer.



### 3.2 Divisional Level

- 3.2.1 The Divisional Development Plan shall be prepared in accordance with the Ten Fold Development Approach after evaluating the feasibility, magnitude and the cost of the development proposals which are submitted subsequent to identification and prioritization at Grama Niladhari Division.
- 3.2.2 In addition to the projects identified by the Rural Committees, “ projects unique to the area which may extend a distinctive contribution and more benefits to the country’s economy and are in line with the criteria pertaining to the Ten Fold Integrated Rural Development Approach”, may be included in the Ten Fold Divisional Development Plan under the guidance of the Divisional Secretary.
- 3.2.3 Out of all the development requirements included in the Ten Fold Divisional Development Plan, projects which may be implemented within the maximum provision of Rs.100 Million allocated for each Divisional Secretariat Division for the year 2024, and may extend maximum benefits to the people of the area and a prompt contribution to the country’s economy shall be identified under the guidance of the Divisional Secretary.
- 3.2.4 These Ten Fold Special Integrated Divisional Development Plans shall be forwarded to the District Secretary with the approval of each Divisional Coordinating Committee **prior to 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024.**
- 3.2.5 The Feasibility Study Report Format specified in **Annexure 3** shall be used to check the feasibility of the infrastructure projects which are expected to be implemented under this Ten Fold Divisional Development Programme and as the preliminary stage, feasibility of the projects selected to be implemented in the year 2024 shall be examined.

### 3.3 District Level

- 3.3.1 The Ten Year Development Plan of the respective district pertaining to the “**Kandukara Dashakaya 2024-2033**”, the Special Integrated Rural Development Programme, including the development proposals forwarded by the respective Divisional Secretariat Divisions and a report containing environmental, social and economic information of the district, shall be prepared and submitted to the Presidential Secretariat by District Secretary **prior to 10<sup>th</sup> of March 2024 with copies to the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Administration, Home Affairs, Provincial Councils and Local Governance and the Secretary to the Ministry of Urban Development and Housing.**



3.3.2 Projects which have been selected to be implemented using the financial provisions allocated for the Financial Year of 2024 shall be referred to the respective Divisional Secretaries so as to be implemented in the Division **subsequent to the approval of the District Secretary** and the approved project information shall be forwarded to the Presidential Secretariat through “**Annexure 4**” without delay for allocating the required financial provisions for the said purpose.

3.3.3 District Secretary shall bear the responsibility of submitting the Ten Fold Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Plan pertaining to the district for the information of the District Coordinating Committee without delay.

#### **4 Implementation**

4.1 Action shall be taken to complete the projects implemented within the year 2024 under “Kandukara Dashakaya 2024-2033”, Ten Fold Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Programme, **prior to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024.**

4.2 Financial provisions required for the projects which have been selected to be implemented within the financial year of 2024, out of the approved projects in accordance with Cabinet Decision made in respect of the Cabinet Memorandum No. 23/2468/601/068 dated 17.12.2023 submitted by the Hon. President and approved by the Cabinet of Ministers on 18.12.2023 shall be released to the respective District Secretary through the Ministry of Urban Development and Housing as per the recommendation of the Secretary to the President.

4.3 District Secretary / Divisional Secretary shall strictly ensure that all rural development projects are implemented within the allocated financial provision limits in terms of the Rules and Regulations, Circulars, Procurement Guidelines and Financial Regulations approved by the Government.

#### **5 Monitoring of the Programme**

5.1 Steps shall be taken to review the divisional and district level progress of the “Kandukara Dashakaya 2024-2033”, Ten Fold Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Programme weekly. A proper mechanism shall be formulated expeditiously for this under the guidance and instructions of District Secretary.

5.2 Rural development projects which are implemented under the “Kandukara Dashakaya 2024-2033”, Ten Fold Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Programme shall constantly be monitored by the Department of Project Management and Monitoring at the national level based on the instructions of the Presidential Secretariat and the relevant instructions and guidelines shall be issued by the said Department in due course.

5.3 Direction and monitoring of this overall programme shall be carried out by the Presidential Secretariat in accordance with the Cabinet Memorandum No. 23/2468/601/068 dated 17.12.2023 submitted by the Hon. President and approved by the Cabinet of Ministers on 18.12.2023 and the necessary information shall be provided by the Department of Project Management and Monitoring.

5.4 Progress of the overall programme shall be constantly monitored at the national level by the Cabinet Sub-committee established under the patronage of the Hon. Prime Minister and the progress and other necessary information shall be submitted to the Cabinet Sub-committee by the Department of Project Management and Monitoring when required.

## **6 Other Matters**

6.1 In respect of the construction projects, a provision not more than 3% of the value of each project and a provision not more than 1% in respect of the non-construction projects may be allocated as administrative expenses and it shall be utilized as follows.

(a) Subject to a maximum of 25% for District Secretariat related activities

(b) Subject to a maximum of 75% for Divisional Secretariat and Implementing Agencies related activities

6.2 Optimal service of the Technical Officers and Technical Assistant Officers attached to Provincial Councils, District Secretariats, Divisional Secretariats, Local Authorities and all Government and Statutory Institutions, situated in the district shall be rendered in order to implement this Ten Fold, Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Project.

6.3 Action shall be taken to ensure the completion of the projects which have been selected to be implemented in the year 2024 under this Ten Fold, Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Project within the year 2024 itself.

6.4 Measures shall be taken to assign two Deputy/ Assistant Directors of the District Secretariat for formulation and coordination of the Ten Fold, Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Plan pertaining to the entire district. Action shall be taken to prevent the carrying forward payments related to this programme from the year 2024.

6.5 All forms of taxes and other payments which are payable related to the projects implemented under "Kandukara Dashakaya 2024-2033", Ten Fold Ten Year Special Integrated Rural Development Programme shall be covered within the provision limits allowed under this programme and no any additional provision shall be allowed for the said purpose.

**Ten Fold Development Sectors based on the Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI)**

**1. Livelihood, Food Security, Market Development and Tourism Promotion**

- i. Provision of short term training and smart technology required for the development of export agriculture sector.
- ii. Empowerment of small and medium scale entrepreneur societies established at rural level.
- iii. Carrying out the modernization of all the fields (agricultural/ fisheries/livestock) of the Agricultural Sector through agro societies. Modernization of agricultural activities, fisheries and livestock fields through agro-societies.
- iv. Empowerment of household industrial societies and industrial villages.
- v. Development of weekly fairs and markets.
- vi. Renovations targeted to utilize the state buildings which have been underutilized or abandoned, for regional/divisional warehouse facilities of other economical venture/process .
- vii. Development of necessary infrastructure facilities for the promotion of tourism. (tourist camp sites, etc)
- viii. Establishment/ improvement of basic necessities for the tourists (access facilities, guides, sanitation facilities, places to visit, resting facilities, safe vehicle parking facilities and other essential facilities) in support of the rural economic process.
- ix. Facilitation for the wellness tourism based on the local and Ayurvedic healthcare system.
- x. Contribution to promote programmes of distributing chicks and Incubators among the rural families and rural entrepreneurs aiming at popularizing chicken egg manufacturing as a remedy to the malnutrition prevalent in the Division.

**2. Education**

- i. Establishment/ improvement of extra class rooms, smart class rooms, laboratories, computer laboratories, library facilities in schools giving priority to primary and secondary schools.
- ii. Provision of sport facilities, modernization and provision of necessary sport equipment.
- iii. Provision of relevant equipment for aesthetic subjects.
- iv. Provision / improvement of drinking water and sanitation facilities in schools.
- v. Improvement of lodging facilities of the teachers currently available at schools.

**3. Drinking Water Facilities**

- i. Construction of public drinking water wells
- ii. Construction of public drinking water tube wells
- iii. Establishment of Reverse Osmosis (RO) systems for public and government entities.
- iv. Extension of drinking pipe line systems.
- v. Establishment of small and medium scale community based drinking water projects.
- vi. Introduction of rain water conservation novel projects aimed at a larger number of beneficiaries.



**4. Access Road Facilities**

- i. Development of rural road.
- ii. Construction of small bridges.
- iii. Construction of earth dams, embankments and drainages
- iv. Development of access roads so as to be used by the differently abled.
- v. Construction of staircases.
- vi. Construction of suspension (hanging) bridges.
- vii. Development of main bus stand.

**5. Agricultural and Minor Irrigation**

- i. Development of agro roads
- ii. Improvement of canals, dams and related facilities
- iii. Construction of threshing floors for public use.

**6. Electricity and Renewable Energy**

- i. Implementation of Rooftop solar panels or other renewable energy projects.
- ii. Extension of power supplies for the benefit of more beneficiaries.
- iii. Installation of solar panel systems in public entities and religious centres.

**7. Telephone, Internet Facilities**

- i. Provision of landline telephone facilities to remote areas.
- ii. Increase of internet facilities and coverage.
- iii. Provision of internet facilities to remote schools.
- iv. Provision of internet facilities to public places under LGN facility

**8. Health and Sanitary Facilities**

- i. Provision and development of essential facilities required for the primary health centres, rural and regional hospitals.
- ii. Provision and improvement of sanitary facilities targeting the public places, on requirement.
- iii. Provision and improvement of essential facilities for Ayurvedic hospitals

**9. Environmental Conservation and Disaster Management**

- i. Taking necessary measures to prevent earth slips and landslides.
- ii. Waste management.
- iii. Projects to minimize soil erosion.
- iv. Creation of new flora systems through implementation of forestation methods in water catchment areas.
- v. Prevention of addition of waste to natural water sources and waterways. Prevention of water pollution.

**10. Upgrading Housing Facilities**

- i. Upgrading houses of poor families (already constructed) as permanent safe houses with the contribution of the community (Maximum of RS. 500,000.00 per house).
- ii. Provision or improvement of sanitary facilities for poor families (giving priority to the households which already do not have sanitary facilities) with the contribution of the community (Maximum of RS. 50,000.00 per family unit).

**Note:**

- In case of any public development purpose which does not come under the foregoing sectors, yet directly contribute to the economic process or to eradication of poverty in the area, special prior approval of the Secretary to the President shall be sought before the implementation of such special projects.
- In case the Rural Committee identifies re-launching of the community water supply projects which have already been commenced yet abandoned on the way due to the scarcity of funds, as major development need, these funds may be allowed to be utilized for such projects.
- In case it is required to seek contribution via Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) of the private sector, for the purpose of making these rural economic development projects successful, Divisional Secretaries may take action in that respect with the approval of the District Secretary.
